Parade Rules

Follow Ye Rules or Walk the Plank!

It should be understood that Ye Krewe of Sir Henry Morgan is always in the public eye and as such we shall conduct ourselves in a manner such as not to bring discredit to the organization. As a Krewe we must abide by the rules of each parade so that we will be invited back again next year.

*If any member or guest walking the parade route becomes intoxicated and beyond control of a Marshal or a member of the executive board, he/she shall be ejected or requested to ride the float. This way there is no danger to themselves or others. Take extra care when drinking and handle yourself properly so that we will all have a good time. Controlled substance will not be tolerated --- they shall not be brought to or consumed on the float or in the parade areas. Vests with embroidered logo or those with logo patches **MUST** be worn during the parade **AT ALL Times**.*

Bead Storage - No cardboard boxes of beads or buckets will be allowed on the float, only two bead bags or backpack per person. Please identify your bag with your name for easy identification. For those walking the parade route, remember to bring your bead belt and/or bead bag. We will have a limited number of spindles on the outside of the float to hang your bead bag. The Krewe is not responsible for your personal possessions stored on the float nor are they liable for any loss or theft of your personal property.

Parade Float - The float is the largest and most expensive asset we own and as such please do your part to take care of it.

Float Rules:

- Use the stairs when boarding the float.
- Hold onto the railing while ascending or descending from the float
- Pay attention to your surroundings; watch for low hanging branches, traffic signals bridges, etc.
- Watch out for the safety of others.
- Assist the Marshals if needed
- During the parade, stay with the float. NO Stopping or Loitering.
- Do not throw or hand out any beads before the parade starting point.
- Do not walk in front of the tow truck, because the driver CANNOT SEE YOU! - Do not walk between the tow truck and the front of the float. This is "NO MAN'S LAND!"
- While on the parade route, DO NOT bend over to pick up beads on the ground.
- If a Krewe or Parade Marshal tells you to move, MOVE! Also, listen to and follow the directions of the Police Officers, Sheriff Deputies, State Troopers and the official parade monitors - They are there for our safety!
- Do not encourage parade spectators to "flash for beads". - Also, Krewe Wenches, NO Flashing either - Please keep your frocks on as these are family parades.
